Who can be a **member** of Beth Ariel Ottawa?

1. Anyone who confesses Yeshua, Jesus the Messiah as his (her) personal Savior and Lord.
2. Anyone who agrees with Beth Ariel's Statement of Faith.
3. Anyone who has been regularly attending Beth Ariel Congregation for 6 months or longer.
4. Anyone who considers Beth Ariel Ottawa as his/her main congregation and who is not a regular member of another congregation. If you are a member of another congregation, you can join us as “friend of Beth Ariel” (please see below).

What are the privileges of a Beth Ariel Ottawa **member**?

1. A member has the privilege of serving in the congregation and exercising his/her spiritual gift(s) to its fullest capacity. This may include the potential of leading a ministry.
2. A member has the privilege to be served by the leadership of the congregation and other members regarding his (her) spiritual, emotional and physical needs. This would include social needs such as weddings, funerals and baby dedications. Marriage and personal counselling are also available for members.
3. A member has the privilege of a voice and vote concerning various administrative and financial issues brought up at the general annual meeting. A member also has the right to approach members of the steering committee and /or the elders regarding suggesting changes or advising on needs which would further edify Beth Ariel Ottawa.
4. A member has access to the *Beth Ariel Internet Prayer Chain* and other pertinent teaching or news and will receive via e-mail or by hard copy any pertinent information about congregational activities.
5. A member has the privilege of attending all congregational activities including Saturday worship services, mid-week bible studies, prayer meetings, men's breakfasts, women's bible studies and conferences and evangelism outreaches.
6. A member has the privilege of supporting the congregation financially. Giving with a cheerful heart is necessary for the growth of the believer and for the congregation's ministries to continue to flourish.

Responsibilities of a **member**:

1. A member has the responsibility to live according to the righteous standards of the Word of God, specified in the Law of Messiah (Gal. 6:2)
2. A member has the responsibility to use his (her) spiritual gifts, to be exercised in a spirit of meekness, faithfulness and agape love (1Cor12:5-7, 1Cor13).
3. A member has the responsibility to attend the congregation on a regular basis.
4. The member should consider the importance of immersion.
